

DEFERRED EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS – 23.02.2022

Following recent amendment of the Non-Citizens (Employment Regulation) Act, Cap 436 through the Written Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 4) Act No. 6 of 2021, which was published in the Government Gazette on 11th October, 2021, extending the time limit for non- citizens to work in Tanzania from five (5) to eight (8) years among other things, the applicants named below who applied for exemption to the Minister responsible for labour and employment matters are advised to lodge application for work permit to exhaust the new time limit provided by the law. Applications should be made to the Labour Commissioner through the new online work permit application and issuance system (OWAIS).
